Anatomic ACL Course (Wet Lab Training)

Thursday 5 May 2011

This one day course will focus intensely on the reconstruction of the Anterior Cruciate Ligament. The day will cover in depth anatomical assessment of the native ligament in situ, the current debate over transtibial drilling versus anteromedial portal reconstructed ACL's and standard ACL reconstruction to complex reconstruction of the partially torn ACL. Delegates will have a chance to perform a variety of ACL reconstruction methods in order to establish their method of choice. The day will involve lectures, discussion, and faculty lead lab time.



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The format of the meeting will be of a series of short lectures and hands-on cadaveric sessions. The course will have a high faculty to delegate ratio and is aimed at consultants practicing all volumes of soft tissue knee surgery.
